The Insurance Bureau of Canada (IBC) report it was the largest insured event in Ontario in five years. (The 2013 Toronto floods caused almost \$1 billion in damage.) We've found a great spot here in Sheffield, and quickly feel like it has become "home". While we are newly established in the village, it has been an active place for over two centuries.

Non-indigenous settlement began in the Sheffield area in 1809. That's the year Rev. John A. Cornell settled here from Dutchess County, New York.



He followed the call to become a preacher in 1812, and founded the first church in Beverly Township (10 minutes south-east of Sheffield). Cornell's congregation went on to build a church in Sheffield by 1834.

Sheffield was known as "The Cornell Settlement" until John A. Cornell named it "Sheffield" when the first post office was established circa 1832. Sheffield's population was 150 people by 1857. The village included a general store/post office,

shoemaker, blacksmith, physician, wagon maker, and hotel. There was also a public school and three churches.

The main road between Cambridge and Hamilton went through Sheffield until 1959 when the Sheffield Bypass was completed. The road through the village is now known as Old Hwy 8. We're excited to be a part of this historic place and look forward to being here for a long time.


